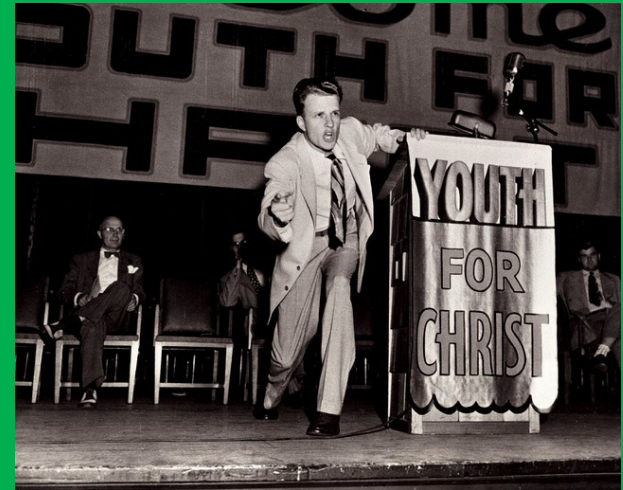

Discipleship

A recent study showed that in the last ten years depression and anxiety has doubled among teens between the ages of 12-17. Because of depression, experts say the results are an increase in drug use and deaths due to drug overdose. Self-mutilation (cutting) is almost a normal thing.

This generation of youth are the most medicated generation that has ever lived. More than 90 percent of them are stressed out and suicide rates are at an alltime high among our youth. In fact, suicide was the second leading cause of death among teenagers. Experts are thinking of lowering this generations life expectancy for the first time since the 1930's. This generation of youth are facing issues that have never been dealt with before like cyber bullying, school shootings, and self-mutilation.

They live in the constant pressure of performance-based culture, where culture sets standard of perfection, that cannot ever be attained. This is generation "Z", but with God all things are possible and that is why the "Verge" youth group exists. The "Verge" is a safe place where youth from all walks of life can come and have fun, feel accepted, be empowered and experience the love of Christ. We teach Jesus in a simple, fresh and relevant way. The mission of the "Verge" is to know Jesus, to be like Jesus and to make Jesus known. We strive to be an authentic, relevant expression of Jesus Christ and His kingdom to this generation. The "Verge" meets Thursdays at the Link at 353 West A. Street. The youth group starts at 6 p.m. and finished by 8 p.m. So come join us as we reveal the living Christ to the youth of our city. *Nate Gallegos, Leader of the Verge Outreach*



Campus Life Outreach

As many of you know we do many Campus life programs and go into many of our schools here in Casper. We are now doing bible studies at Kelly Walsh, Roosevelt, and soon we will be doing a bible study in First Christian Church for the youth at NCHS. We also go into CY middle school and do bible studies in 7th. and 8th grade. We go into Centennial Middle school and have bible studies in 7TH. and 8TH grade. WE average about 25 youth in each bible study. It is quite amazing how God has opened all these doors for us.

I just want to share a praise report about what happened in one of our bible studies at 8TH grade Centennial. We have a very wonderful volunteer that leads the bible study at Centennial, and she attends a local church here in Casper that meets at the Mall. A few weeks ago, she had someone from her church come and speak to the youth at our bible study. The man she invited was going to be starting a church in Barr Nunn, Wyoming. He came and spoke to the kids and at the end asked if anyone would like to surrender their lives to Jesus. With all heads bowed, one of the youth raised his hand to surrender his life to Jesus. The great thing is that the young man who raised his hand lived in Barr Nunn where the speaker was going to start a church. So, the young man that raised his hand now has a future church he can go to and be discipled and maybe his whole family. I think that is pretty amazing!
