I recently took one of the youth that comes to our free lunch out for breakfast. I just wanted to show kindness to him and to ask about what is happening in his life. Our youth today are facing and dealing with many issues in their lives and they sometimes just need someone to talk to even just vent.

This young man who had been coming to our free lunch for some time and had gotten to know our staff and now trusted us, was able to speak to me about some of the issues he was dealing with. I sat there and listened to him, and thought "How many youth of our city are dealing with issues that they think there is no answer for? We know the only answer to many of life's difficulties and problems is Jesus and His love for us. I was able to tell this young man about the peace that only Christ can give, and it is a peace that brings joy with it.

### CY Campus Life Exploding with Youth!



I had no idea what I was in for when I signed up to lead Campus Life at Cy Middle School. It began over two years ago with six 7th graders, a few pizzas and two 2 liters of coke all stuffed in a small

auxiliary classroom that wasn't being used. Today we have 13 pizzas, 4-5 two liters of coke, a blue wagon to get it all in the building and an average of 50+ 8th graders all stuffed in a science classroom. I thought that keeping 6 students' attention at school would be a challenge, and now I just laugh at that thought. I have been blessed beyond my imagination by these students over the last few years. I have had the blessing and opportunity to impact the lives of these students and bring the love of Jesus Christ to them.

What blows me away is what these kids are going through day after day. They are in desperate need of the love of Jesus showing up through people around them. They have learned how not to trust and it takes time and consistency to change that. They need lots of prayer and support. I would love to invite you to join us in this battle for the lives of our teens. While ministering to youth recently at the Natrona County Juvenile Detention Center, we discov-

ered that several youth were from various towns in the state of Wyoming as well as other states. It is sobering to think that we may only meet these youth only once. What we impart to them may effect their perspective of God for the rest of their lives. It is always a priority for us to share God's Word, the message of the cross, and to take time out to pray for them individually. It is especially during the prayer time where many of them sensed God's presence surrounding them as well as speaking into their lives the Father heart of God. There is one young man in particular that we can remember praying for who began to weep. He was very broken and quiet, but when we started to pray with him, his countenance changed and he appeared to have God's peace instead of the anxiety on his face that I saw before we prayed.
