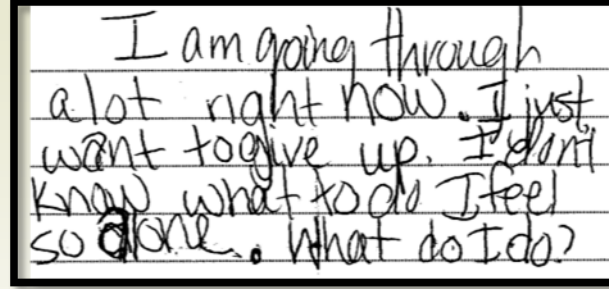

A Juvenile Detention Center Connection

A few weeks ago, we were out running errands and stopped in one of the Convenience stores. I heard someone call my name and it was one of the youth from JDC.
