Once a month, I, along with another chaplain, do a church service at the Natrona County Detention Center (adult jail). A female came to our meeting whom we had ministered to in the Natrona County Juvenile Detention Center (NCJDC). She remembered us from the NCJDC and seemed happy to see a familiar face. She began to open up about how horrible things were going in her life. We shared our personal testimonies with her and she began to cry. **We were able to lead her to Christ that morning.** She will be doing 2-4 years in the Wyoming Women’s Center in Lusk, Wyoming. Although she never accepted Christ at the NCJDC, I know the fruit we saw that morning was a result of what was sown through our CYFC volunteers and staff throughout the couple of years she spent off and on in the NCJDC. We referred her to a prison ministry that ministers once a month at the Wyoming Women’s Center in Lusk.

During the summer months we try and do as much outreach as we can to the youth of our city. We are now doing a hot dog outreach three days a week in different parts of the city of Casper. It

amazing how just using something as simple as hot dogs, chips and sodas can help share the Gospel with the youth of our city. Along with handing out hot dogs, we are also able to offer youth a Bible or some type of Gospel literature that they can take home. Many times the parents of these youth also come out for a hot dog and then they ask questions about who we are and why we are giving away free

hot dogs. In this exchange, we are able to speak with them about the love of God. At one of our outreaches we came across a soccer camp with about 25 youth and were able to tell them about Casper



Youth for Christ and what we do. During these summer months it is so important to get out and share the Gospel with as many youth as possible and let them know that there is a God who loves them and cares for them and their families. At one of the locations where I do the hot dog outreach, some of the youth are outside waiting for me when I arrive. I have said this before and that is, "that for many of these youth we are the only example of Jesus and His love they will come in contact
