She has used the pain of her circumstances to make a difference in the lives of others. Thank you Jenny for all you do in our community! **In 2018, Natrona County (NC) had 24 suicides. In 2019, there have already been 18 suicides in NC. Nationally, there is one suicide to every five attempts.** It is important that we pray and do everything in our power to help those in need.
