We met Amy's sons at our Lunch at the Link Outreach this last school year. Amy came in one day to learn more about our lunch program and we got to know her as well. Recently, they were evicted from their home and were trying to get to Cheyenne.



The tires to her vehicle were bald, she had no gas, no food and they had no place to stay. They came here to eat lunch and stay out of the sun. When Amy shared her need, we were able to get her help, thanks to our amazing community. Greta who helps with the homeless provided a tank of gas and two tires. Leo's Garage provided two more tires and River of Life Church paid for hotel rooms. La Cocina gave them a gift card and CYFC prayed over them for a safe journey. I can't imagine the challenges youth face not to have a home, food and the bare necessities of life.
