I have found out that many of our youth are just looking for someone to love them and care about them and the issues they are facing. "Love never fails" and that is what we desire to demonstrate to our youth, the wonderful and powerful love of God.

A "JESUS" Encounter

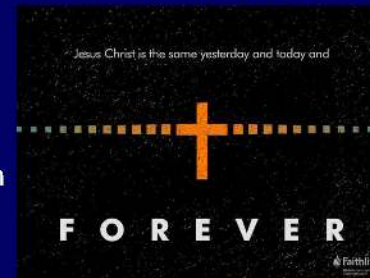
